The ideal candidate is a community member who wants to take an important role in providing oversight and compliance monitoring during archaeology, forestry, mining, and construction projects in Peters First Nation's territory.

This position will require travel as directed by Landmark Resource Management and its clients.

Required Qualifications

- High school diploma.
- Willingness to take training.
- Ability to travel.
- On-call shift work; or up to 7 days on, 7 days off while in the field. Can be discussed and may change depending on the project and Peters First Nation's demands.

- Desire to attend college or university.
- Experience working with fish, bird, wildlife, and vegetation assessments/surveys.
- Experience working on construction sites.

Location: The Fraser Valley and Lower Mainland. Most of the work is field based in the Fraser Valley with office time for reporting, administration, and project meetings. Both on and off-reserve Peters First Nation members are encouraged to apply.

Compensation: \$28-40 per hour, depending on experience. Daily living out allowance is also provided while in the field.
